

## You Helped Nyeshia Find Stability



Nyeshia and her daughters arrived at the Life Haven Shelter after spending nights at the bus station. Before that, they were in a motel. Her apartment had become uninhabitable due to mold and lead contamination, causing her baby to get sick. Despite having a good rental history and a steady job, she found herself homeless.

The current demand for shelter from families is higher than it has been in decades. However, Nyeshia secured a spot at Life Haven and upon arrival, was paired with a New Reach Case Worker. Nyeshia's goal was clear from the beginning: **"I want to find another apartment for myself and my children."** 

Nyeshia found strength in her love for her kids and was determined to provide them with a safe home. In just 60 days, she completed her housing plan, showing her resilience and determination to create a better future for her family.

Nyeshia's story is just one of thousands that shows the impact of your support for New Reach. Together, we inspire lasting independence and stability for those in their time of crisis and need.

## YOU BAG, YOU DELIVER, YOU FEED THE HOMEBOUND

On January 1st, 2023, **FISH of Greater New Haven became part of New Reach**, enhancing our efforts to fight food insecurity. FISH's mission is to deliver groceries to our homebound neighbors (the only program that does this in the State of Connecticut!). Last year, FISH supported 875 households!

#### The power of FISH lies within its over 120 volunteers.

Every month, they prepare and deliver over 2,500 bags of groceries to those who, due to age or illness, are unable to access stores or food pantries.

#### **Client Success Stories**

MARIA, 68, sought help in September 2023 due to severe osteoarthritis and type 1 diabetes, which made everyday tasks agonizing. Despite health issues, she always worked, but worsening conditions led to job loss when she could no longer commute by bus. Facing financial strain, Maria felt overwhelmed, and was physically unable to access food pantries. Connecting with FISH provides her with a monthly delivery of groceries, allowing her to focus on her health.



John and his mother depend on a caregiver three times a week. Without FISH, accessing nutritious food would be nearly impossible.

## Thank you Neil Mellen -Town Fair Tire Foundation-

Like you, Neil Mellen was a champion for New Reach. Neil opened the first Town Fair Tire in Fairfield, Connecticut in 1967. Fueled by relentless determination, the company grew to 115 locations across New England. It was during this growth that Neil founded the Town Fair Tire Foundation.

Neil was a man of uncommon compassion and integrity. Under his stewardship, the Foundation became a significant benefactor to New Reach, as well as many other


